“Every report made by a patient, a healthcare professional, or a carer plays a key role in gaining more knowledge about the benefits and risks of medicines in clinical use and allows action to be taken to minimise risks.

“Reporting suspected side effects to the Pharmacy Board of Sierra Leone helps to improve the safety of medicines for all patients and, in some cases, can result in better tailored prescribing advice, which can improve patient outcomes.

“If you or a patient you are supporting experience a side effect with a medicine, make sure to report it to us promptly.”

Anyone including all health professionals can report suspected side effects to the Pharmacy Board of Sierra Leone.
